



There are now 882 e-Learning Anaesthesia 'lessons' live and immediately available online to registered UK anaesthetists (July 2009).

E-SESSIONS

ACCS trainees and anaesthetists in their first two years of anaesthesia should check out the 241 formal e-learning sessions covering the basic sciences and general or regional anaesthesia relevant to clinical placements in theatres, critical care medicine, paediatric anaesthesia, geriatrics, labour ward, and pain clinics.

E-ASSESSMENT

Trainees approaching the Primary and Final FRCA exams are also able to test the breadth of their knowledge base using 79 e-Assessment practice sessions that incorporate MCQ questions typical of those to be encountered in the real examination. Each session is

accompanied by feedback helping trainees to target their revision more effectively.

E-LIBRARY

The e-Library is available to both trainees and fellows, allowing toll-free access to 562 selected journal and book articles in portable document format (pdf). These articles can be printed or saved for later reference and help form the basis of targeted e-CPD activity.
