ROYAL COLLEGE OF ANAESTHETISTS CENSUS REPORT 2003

As at 26 September 2003

Summary of Census Returns

Census date was 14 March 2003

298 Anaesthetic Departments were requested to take part in the Census.

Approximately 3% (10 Hospitals) of those asked failed to return any data.

Total Returns: 288 departments or 97%.

NOTES:

Dates of Birth were received from 4667 of 4921 Consultants (95%), 1076 of 1172 NCCGs (91%), and 165 of 209 Locums (79% - Consultants and NCCGs). Dates of birth were also received from 2867 of 3365 trainees (85%).

Although departments were again asked to list their trainees and their grades, SHO and SpR years 1-5, training grades were not stated for 205 trainees (6%).

This year the departments were asked to provide details of where (Town/Country) their anaesthetists undertook their Primary Medical Education. 76% of all Anaesthetists provided this information.





Summary of Primary Medical Education of all grades by location

This year the departments were asked to provide details of where (Town/Country) their anaesthetists undertook their Primary Medical Education (PME). From a total of 9667 Anaesthetists, of all grades, 7343 (or 76%) indicated where they had undertaken their PME.

- Out of 4921 substantive Consultants this information was provided for a total of 3638 people (74%). Of this number, 2984 undertook their PME in the UK (82%).
- Of 1172 substantive NCCGs, 823 (70%) had indicated where they had undertaken their PME. Of this number, 255 undertook their PME in the UK (31%), and 568 undertook their PME outside the UK (69%).
- Of 180 Locums Consultants, 119 indicated where they had undertaken their PME (66%). Of this number, 56 undertook their PME in the UK (47%).
- Of 29 Locums NCCGs, 24 indicated where they had undertaken their PME (82%). Of this number, 11 undertook their PME in the UK (46%).
- Of 3365 Trainees, 2739 indicated where they had undertaken their PME (81%). Of this number, 1692 undertook their PME in the UK (62%).
