

ACCS 2021 Curriculum Implementation Checklist

This document is intended to support Heads of School, ACCS Leads and Training Programme Directors in making a smooth transition to the new ACCS Curriculum in August 2021.

- Ensure senior trainers and educational supervisors have familiarised themselves with the new curriculum. Resources can be found on the ACCS website at: https://www.accs.ac.uk/accs/2021-curriculum/resources
- Ensure all current and incoming trainees have a named Educational Supervisor assigned for a minimum period of one year - see the recent HEE/GMC/NACT Standards in Supervision document found at: https://www.hee.nhs.uk/sites/default/files/documents/Standards_4pp_Update_v2.pdf
- Access and distribute the ACCS ARCP Decision Aid found at: https://www.rcoa.ac.uk/sites/default/files/documents/2021-04/ACCS%20ARCP%202021-2%20Decision%20Aid.pdf
- Identify trainees who are out-of-sync' (LTFT, sickness absence, maternity leave) and on OOP to plan transition. This will usually be once they finish their current placement but those very early on or near the end of a placement may be better moving across in August.
- Ensure Emergency Medicine and Anaesthesia trainees have the relevant information to access their new e-portfolio.
- Ensure current and incoming ACCS trainees have access to key curriculum resources found on the ACCS website and including the FAQs document found at:
